


# Installing Forcepoint Certificate for Android devices



- 1) Connect to the BYOD wireless network and login with your network credentials (what you log into the computers with)





- 2) Log into the ForcePoint Authentication page using the same credentials
- 3) With the phone browser navigate to this webpage using the address bar in the browser. **https://forcepoint.islipufsd.org** (remember the "HTTPS://")
- 4) Click on "Download certificate"



- 5) The certificate should be downloaded into your “downloads” folder. Open the application called “My Files” (if you can’t find it, you can search for it in your app tray) and navigate to Internal Storage, then navigate to download. (It is named **iufsdip-rootcert.cer**)
- 6) Hold down your finger on the certificate until it is checked
- 7) Tap Move on the bottom of the screen
- 8) Navigate to Internal storage (you move back one screen) and tap “Move here”



- 9) Navigate to your settings app and tap Biometrics and Security
- 10) Tap Other Security settings
- 11) Tap install from phone storage
- 12) Tap on the certificate that is there and rename the certificate name to IslipUFSD. Make sure the “Used for” field says VPN and apps



- 13) Test out the certificate by going to a website like Wikipedia or noodletools.com
